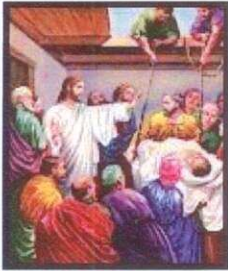

Stational Churches . . When one thinks of the season of Lent, ashes, palm branches, the Stations of the Cross, meatless Fridays may be customs and practices that come to mind. Perhaps, the observance of the Roman Stational Churches would not make our list of Lenten practices. Each day in the season of Lent is associated with one of the churches in Rome. On that day people will visit the designated church recalling its history, reflecting on its patron saint and spending time in prayer. It is unlikely that many of us will visit the Roman Stational Churches this Lent, so we are adapting this Roman custom to our local situation. We will visit five of Spokane's churches.
